





Coronavirus health monitor

CVM-Health™ is an easy to use web-based software application that provides a secure way to record health conditions, COVID-19 symptoms, vital signs and medications during the pandemic.

The app is free to anyone in the UK, and provides a secure way for individuals and families, sick or well, to monitor and support the management of their health for any COVID-19 related symptoms.

The app also enables individuals to ‘be a good neighbour’ by helping remotely monitor and care for members of their family or community who are at risk from Coronavirus.



Record your health conditions, symptoms, vital signs and medications



The app does not record your location or track you in any way. Your personal information is not shared with anyone



Create health diaries for people without access to the internet

Those registering to use the app must be over 18 but once registered the app can be used to monitor anyone’s health, regardless of their age. For example, a parent can monitor their children’s health.

Build a community. Help fight COVID-19.


Help build a community to fight COVID-19, be a ‘good neighbour’ for people with poor technology literacy or with no access to the internet.


CVm-Health is aimed at:

Features

- Record vital sign data (temperature, blood pressure, blood oxygenation and pulse)
- Record symptoms (cough, fever, shortness of breath, reduced activity levels, fatigue, loss of smell/taste)
- Record coronavirus status (as assessed by a clinical test)
- Record relevant risk factors and comorbidities
- View the most recent vital signs and symptoms information

Free, easy to use, accessible across all devices (mobile, tablet, laptop, PC).

Creates a personalised digital health record for those in most need of care, based on the vital signs data and symptom information recorded in the app.

Does not record an individual's location or track people in any way. All personal data is anonymised, securely stored on the cloud as a completely isolated instance with rigorous data security and privacy measures.
